



Preparing Your Quilt for Drop-off, Dropping Off and Picking Up Your Quilt

Sleeve: Each quilt must have a 3" sleeve sewn or securely pinned (with safety pins) to the back upon delivery. Failure to provide a sleeve will result in the quilt not being shown.

For quilts longer than 84". The maximum hanging length from the top of the sleeve to the bottom of the quilt is 84". For quilts longer than 84", safety pin the extra length up from the bottom or locate the sleeve (sewn or safety pinned on) so that the total hanging length is no more than 84" from the top of the sleeve to the bottom of the quilt.

Label: Each quilt must have a label (4" x 4" works well) stitched to a bottom corner of the back with the following information on it:

- your name
- your phone number
- quilt title
- quilt width and length

Condition: Quilts must be free of lint, odors, pet hair or other debris.

Packaging: Each quilt must be in a separate clear, large zip loc bag with handles with the quilt label showing. Print your name and phone number in large black letters on the opening edge of the bag.

Mailing Your Quilt: You may mail your quilt(s) if you live out of the area. Mail in time to arrive between May 5 and May 15, 2022 to the address below:

Entrants are responsible for the cost of mailing the quilts both ways. Include appropriate packaging and a prepaid UPS or FedEx return mailing label for all entries, both national and international, tracked/signature required. Entrants are responsible for tracking their own packages.

Pick-Up: Sunday, May 22, 2022, between 5:00 and 6:00 PM. You must have your pick-up pass(es). If someone else is picking up your quilt(s) for you, he/she must have your pick-up pass(es).

Mail Return: Entrants are responsible for the cost of mailing the quilts both ways. Include appropriate packaging and a prepaid UPS or FedEx return mailing label for all entries, both national and international, tracked/signature required. Entrants are responsible for tracking their own packages.
