English Paper Piecing by Machine I Friday, June 4, 2021

Do you love but avoid the traditional one-patch? Handwork is wonderful, but let's explore an innovative machine technique, useful for any pattern that would be English paper pieced, without compromising the integrity of the original. We begin with hexagons, then move quickly to a Sunburst star (like in the pictured quilt, simplified for class). You'll enjoy having this in your bag of tricks!

Supply list:

- 10-15 fat quarters (or equivalent) from stash, some of which should read solid.
- Fabric scissors, rotary cutting tools, invisible monofilament thread, offset tweezers
- (optional), straight pins, pin-able ironing personal ironing board (pins will stand straight up during use - June Tailor Cushioned Quilter's Square 'n Blocker from JoAnn is best; doubled, covered foam core also works).
- Personal craft iron

Kit includes pattern sheets, knife, glue, poster board.
